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## Registration Information

Please complete a registration form and send/return as soon as possible to the Business Office in the Spring Street School. A deposit (\$125 for the two-day program and \$200 for the three-day program) is required and will be considered your last month's (June) tuition payment.

**This program is open for West Bridgewater Residents only.**

The program offers two different sections based on age. The Monday, Wednesday, Friday sessions (morning and afternoon) is appropriate for children age 4 by August 31, 2010. Space is limited to 12 children per session. The Tuesday and Thursday morning session is appropriate for children age 3 by August 31, 2010. Space is limited to 10 children per session.

**Applications and deposits will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis.**

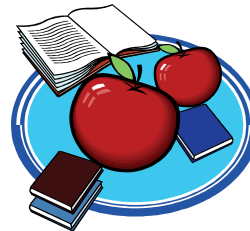
All students **MUST** be potty-trained before the start of school.
